SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- A. Permittee shall construct the permitted works in accordance with the approved plans, a copy of which is on file in this office. All work shall be performed to the satisfaction of the district's inspector.
- B. All excavations shall be backfilled and compacted to a relative density of at least 90% of the maximum density as determined by the "Five Layer Method" as specified in California Test Method No. 216C, 1956. Reconstruction of the existing channel slopes and invert may be necessary for the installation of the drainage facilities. The necessary reconstruction shall be performed as directed by and to the satisfaction of the district's inspector.
- C. At least 24 hours prior to the commencement of any work contemplated by this permit, permittee shall notify district's Maintenance Superintendent by telephone at 534-0336 or by writing, addressed to him at 13872 East Garden Grove Boulevard, Orange, California.
- D. By acceptance of this permit, permittee agrees that the rip rap lining to be constructed within the district's right of way shall become the property of the district and the district shall be responsible for its maintenance. The permittee shall be responsible for the proper operation, the maintenance and the replacement of the tide gates, the discharge lines, and all other devices for the purpose of preventing back flow of water from district's works.
- E. This permit may be cancelled by the Board of Supervisors in the event the use permitted is abandoned for a period exceeding one year.
- F. Permittee in accepting this permit stipulates that it is fully aware of the relationship between the probable flood stage elevations in district's facility and those of the streets, and other improvements to be drained into district's facility. Permittee agrees to hold district, its officers, employees and agents harmless from any and all penalties, liabilities or losses resulting from claims or court actions arising from damage or injury to persons and property by reason of the installation, operation, or failure of the works to be constructed under this permit.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- G. The district may in the future reconstruct the East Garden Grove-Wintersburg Channel and construct concrete slope paving within the channel in the area of the proposed pumping plant discharge lines. Permittee agrees to construct either the permanent outlet structures shown on the approved plans, or some other permanent outlet works mutually approved by permittee and district, at the time of the district's reconstruction and improvement of the East Garden Grove-Wintersburg Channel.
- H. Prior to any construction work within the district's right of way, permittee's contractor shall survey and set the necessary lines and grades for the proposed construction work and notify the district when said surveys have been completed. District shall then check the lines and grades with its own surveyors or inspectors and permittee agrees that construction work will not commence until the district's inspector has certified that the lines and grades are satisfactory to the district.
- I. By the acceptance of this permit, permittee stipulates that he is aware of the fact that the district's channel is subject to ground subsidence in this area, which may cause damage to the proposed discharge lines. Permittee agrees to hold the district harmless from any such damage.
